

Important things to know!



Brightwheel Info: Brightwheel is a tool used by staff to do general upkeep and manage our classrooms in a singular place.

1. All students are required to sign up for Brightwheel because this is how student will check in and out for school. Attendance will be taken and put into Brightwheel every day. When students arrive in the morning, parents have the option of downloading the app to check their student in, or use the kiosk provided inside of the facility.
2. Brightwheel will also be a part of how students are health screened in the morning following Covid-19 guidelines. Upon arrival parents will be required to submit a questionnaire regarding the student's health. We will also be taking temperatures at the door to ensure the health and safety of all individuals, including all staff and visiting parents that enter the building and plan on staying a while.
3. Brightwheel is also how we will communicate throughout the day with families. All staff will have an email that we can be reached at, but a lot of communication will be done through Brightwheel. Students educational progress can be updated as well as any small concerns, I.e., if your student falls and scrapes his knee, we will make you aware of that through Brightwheel.

ABC Jesus Loves Me

Weekly Worship with Pastor Jessica

It is a priority at Journey Preschool that we develop preschoolers academically and spiritually. Once a week on Wednesdays, the children will meet with Pastor Jessica for a 30-minute worship and bible time. The bible time will follow the ABC Jesus Loves Me weekly curriculum. The students will be read a story and taught a lesson or theme that follows. For example, students will be learning the story of Noah's Ark, which follows the theme of Obedience. So, throughout the week students will be reminded of what it means to be faithful and obedient. This information will also be on the weekly breakdown of student's lessons.
